Celestine is a 59-foot Voyage sailing catamaran, built in 2020: open-plan living, five ensuite queen cabins, air conditioning all night, and a chef who lives aboard.

Up to 10 guests have room to gather and space to retreat. A professional crew of three handles the sailing, the cooking, and the details, so every day is easy and every anchorage feels like home.

Flybridge

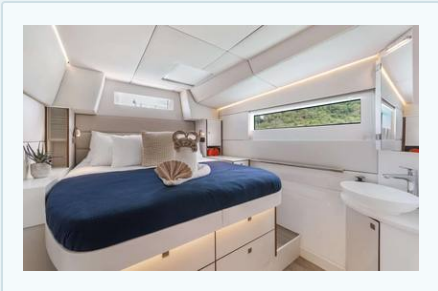
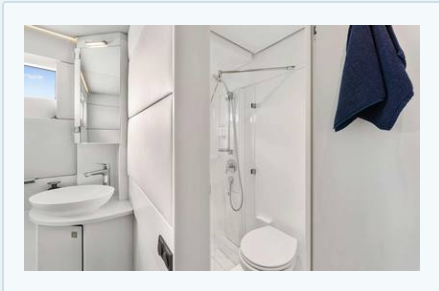
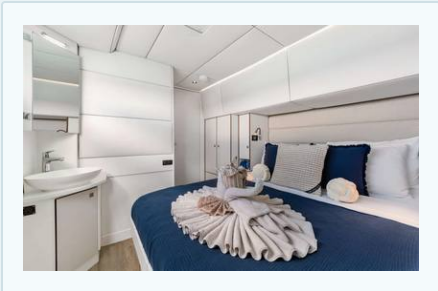
Made for sunset cocktails and wide Caribbean views.

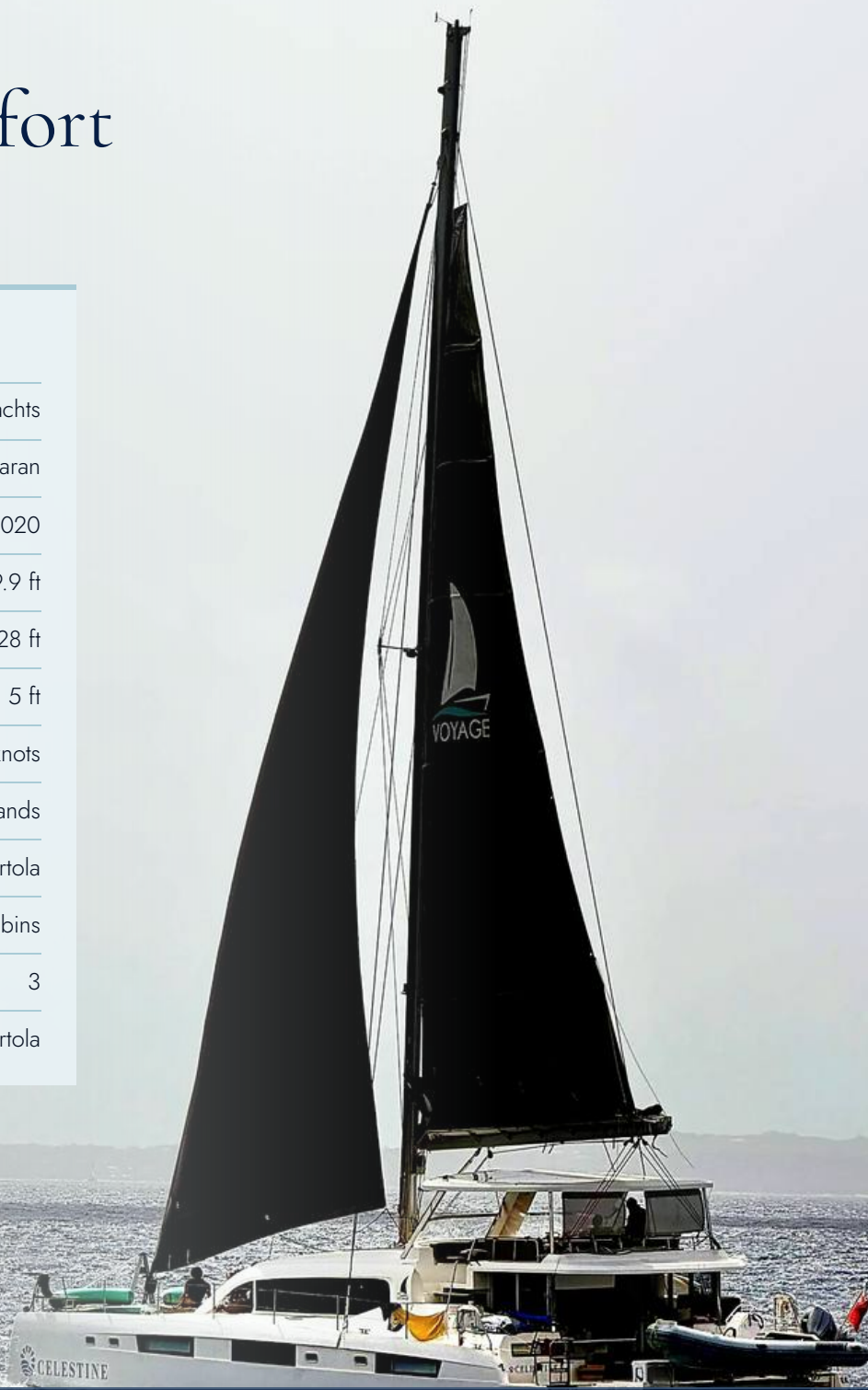
CABIN LAYOUT

From daybreak to sweet finishes

Relaxed breakfasts, midday favorites, plated dinners, and cocktails made for life aboard. Your chef plans each menu around your tastes, so treat these as samples.



DAY BREAK

Eggs Benedict

Poached eggs, crispy bacon or smoked salmon, hollandaise

Smoked salmon bagels

Toasted bagels, cream cheese, and capers

Fresh mango, coconut cream, or caramelized pineapple

Weekly charter rates

Split among couples, a week aboard *Celestine* rivals the price of an upscale cruise ship cabin, and for families it compares with hotels or vacation rentals plus dining out. The rate is *all-inclusive*: crew, meals, drinks, fuel, and water toys.

Shorter charters

Five nights is the minimum. Ask us about anything shorter. Six nights is the weekly rate ÷ 7 × 6. Five nights or fewer is the weekly rate ÷ 6 × the number of nights.

Sleep aboard

Board the evening before, after 4 PM, for 50% of the daily rate. Snacks, welcome cocktails, and a continental breakfast are included, and dinner is ashore at your expense. Not offered in Christmas and New Year's weeks.

Boarding

We prefer Yacht Haven Grande, St. Thomas. Crown Bay Marina, St. Thomas, and Nanny Cay and Frenchman's Cay marinas, Tortola, are also available. British Virgin Islands boarding needs advance approval, and an annual limit applies.
